What is Club Tanzanite?

All monies donated to the SAVF are invested mainly into veterinary research in South Africa. Some deserving causes or projects are also supported in cases where the board has agreed to sponsor such work. The SAVF is also passionately involved in supporting work with rhinos in South Africa and is helping to make a difference. Funds are apportioned to projects approved by the board after intense review and analysis of proposals and requests. The SAVF is a registered non-profit and public benefit organisation.

How do I become a member?

Club Tanzanite operates on a tier system with a minimum contribution per tier per financial year. Contributions are cumulative and all count towards final standings at the end of the financial year. By simply making a donation you automatically become an entry level tier member of Club Tanzanite, with associated benefits. Any subsequent contributions serve to move one up through the various tiers.
